

## FAC Awards' 17<sup>th</sup> Edition: I'm Taking Part

Again this year, the Fédération autonome du collégial is organizing its FAC Awards contest. This event recognizes the professional excellence of college teachers in pedagogical or union activities. The winners will win \$750.

### Contest Categories

1. The "Document" category consists of books or lecture notes, the content of which is intended for teaching purposes (and not for publication) and, therefore, not subject to royalties.
2. The "Pedagogical Activity" category includes outstanding learning experiences within the regular framework of a teacher's course, a stage or a laboratory project. These can be pedagogical methods or activities in a particular class. The activity could also be the result of teamwork by teachers from one or several departments.
3. The "Contribution to College Life" category refers to an activity or project connected to the field of teaching and carried out by a teacher, leading to benefits for the college or the community.
4. The "Union Involvement" category consists of a project or an activity that has helped to improve the teaching conditions or working lives of unionized teachers.

### Eligibility Criteria

Any teacher who is a member of FAC and who does not hold a position, with paid release time, with the federation.

The activity (in the broad sense):

- must have been carried out in 2007-2008 or 2008-2009;
- must not be part of program reviews under any provincial coordination.

The project must have been carried out in the context of a teacher performing his or her teaching duties, without having received remuneration for this purpose or having been on full-time release for a session or more.
