Austerity: More Cutbacks in Cegep Budgets

Education Minister Yves Bolduc recently announced, part-way through the academic year, a further cut of 19 million dollars for the cegep system this year. This 19 million is in addition to the \$109,000,000 cut from cegep budgets in the past 4 years. For example, Cegep Gaspe, a small regional cegep already having many problems, will be cut a total of \$600,000 this year! Even the Federation des cegeps (cegep administrators) is against the cutbacks saying that these will certainly affect students, especially students who are already at risk. In a recent interview, Vanier DG, Norman Bernier, said that the \$19 million will be divided amongst the 48 cegeps, but bigger cegeps will be more affected. We may have more information about how Vanier will be affected soon since there have been questions to the Vanier Board put on the agenda of the meeting this Tuesday.

These cuts are part of the general AUSTERITY measures now being put in place by the Quebec government. As part of the **REFUSE AUSTERITY** campaign, there will be a demonstration Saturday, Nov. 29 at 1pm. (gathering starts at noon) at Place du Canada (corner of Peel and Rene-Levesque). Attached you will find a leaflet on different ways that the austerity campaign will affect us.
