## **College Committees**

After a fantastic response from interested teachers, we have filled the positions of teacher representatives for the Research Ethics Board, the Complementary Course Committee, and the Cafeteria User Committee. We thank all of the teachers who put their names forward. It is this kind of willingness to be involved that will help us reclaim proper consultation. #### **CRT (Labour Relations Committee)**

Various teachers have informed the VCTA that classrooms in N 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> floors, and E 5<sup>th</sup> floor, and some classrooms in A 5<sup>th</sup> floor were extremely hot the first few weeks of class. Fans were installed as soon as the problem was reported, but long-term solutions are needed. The Executive has taken this to CRT (the Labour Relations Committee) as this is a working-conditions issue, and we are waiting to hear about their plan to resolve this problem.

We have brought the questions of teacher resources for students with disabilities to CRT and were told that the administration does not need to discuss this with us but merely inform us of their decision on how to use these funds (now for two years rolled over, approximately \$640 000). We disagree and believe this issue should involve consultation with teachers as to how these funds could be used in the classroom so as to be most useful.

We have put in a grievance as a result of the new decision to charge teachers Fitness Centre fees.

The next CRT is scheduled for Sept. 29<sup>th</sup> at 2pm in the Boardroom (F 216). All teachers are encouraged to attend.

## **Grades Review Committee**

Be kindly reminded that, according to the Collective Agreement, the teacher whose grade is being contested and is brought to the Grades Review Committee has a right to sit on the Grades Review Committee (Article 4-1:10). In addition, only the teacher or the Grades Review Committee has the right to change a student's grade (Article 8-1:02). It is important that these rules are uniformly followed.
